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b) Survey to cover both Malborough and South Huish Parishes:

It was agreed that a survey to cover both parishes is essential to enable SMASH to ascertain exactly what the parishes would like to see/do in respect of sustainability. The results will then be collated and turned into a working document to cover a given number of years. The working document will be used by SMASH to provide evidence to both councils that their plans and actions are aligned with the needs and wants of the parishes. A separate survey for children could also be produced.

TA will put the basis of the survey together so that the remaining members of the sub-committee can add their thoughts prior to it being created. Timescale created by June, issued and promoted June/July, survey closes 1st August.
